



# TEHACHAPI MOUNTAIN PARK

Tehachapi Mountain Park, established in 1952, covers 490 acres. The Park is located eight miles southwest of Tehachapi, a full service community. Elevation above sea level ranges from 5,500 - 7,500 feet. Forests, four season weather, natural spring water, hiking, mountain-biking and equestrian trails all contribute to make this an ideal recreation area yearlong.

The facilities at Tehachapi Mountain Park include 61 first come/first serve family campsites. Camping fee is \$18 per day per campsite. Campsites are limited to 10 persons, one motorized vehicle and one trailer. Senior citizens 62 years or older and Disabled receive a \$2 discount. All fees are payable in advance for the period desired and are not refundable. A registration fee drop box is located near the entrance to the park. Visitors are asked to fill out the permit, deposit the fee in the box, and post the receipt at the campsite. Camping stays are limited to 14 days (a day is any 24 hour period commencing at 2:00 pm) peak season and 31 days off season. Quiet hours are 10 pm - 7 am. Check-in time is 2:00 pm and Check-out time is 12:00 pm.

## Group Reservation Areas

**Tehachapi Mountain Camp**, a group reservation camp (minimum 40 and maximum 100 people) include ten cabins. Each cabin has ten bunk beds, electricity and heating. There is a cook's cabin with shower and toilet facilities. The kitchen-dining building (capacity 100 persons) has electricity, hot water, refrigerator, freezer, propane stove, and cooking utensils. An accessible building with four restrooms and two showers is located near the cabins. A shower building is located near the mess hall and houses five men's showers and five women's showers.

**Sierra Flats** may also be reserved for group camping. It will accommodate up to 15 vehicles and 150 people. There is a picnic shelter with tables, pit toilets, BBQ grills, and water available.

## Special Provisions

**Firearms** The discharge of firearms or other weapons is prohibited. This includes such weapons as firearms, bow and arrows, spears, BB guns and sling shots.

**Animals** All domestic animals must be kept on a leash. Horses must be kept on designated trails only and are not allowed in campgrounds. A ten horse corral is located adjacent to the Horseshoe campgrounds.

**Fires** Keep all fires in designated fireplaces. Extinguish fires when leaving the campsite. Bring an adequate supply of fire wood. No cutting or removal of trees and shrubs is allowed in the park.

**Vehicles** Off-road vehicles cannot be operated in park. All vehicles must be street licensed and may be operated on designated roads only. Parts of the park may be closed during the winter due to unsafe road conditions. All winter campers and visitors are advised to carry chains. No more than 1 motor vehicle and 1 vehicular trailer shall occupy a campsite used for camping purposes. No trailers or camping will be allowed outside of designated areas. Trailers shall not connect to water faucets by any means.

**Waste Disposal** Pack it in – Pack it out. Please take your refuse and recyclables home with you. Otherwise, deposit all refuse in the receptacles that are provided for this purpose. RV dump facilities are not available in the park. The closest RV dump station is located in Tehachapi.

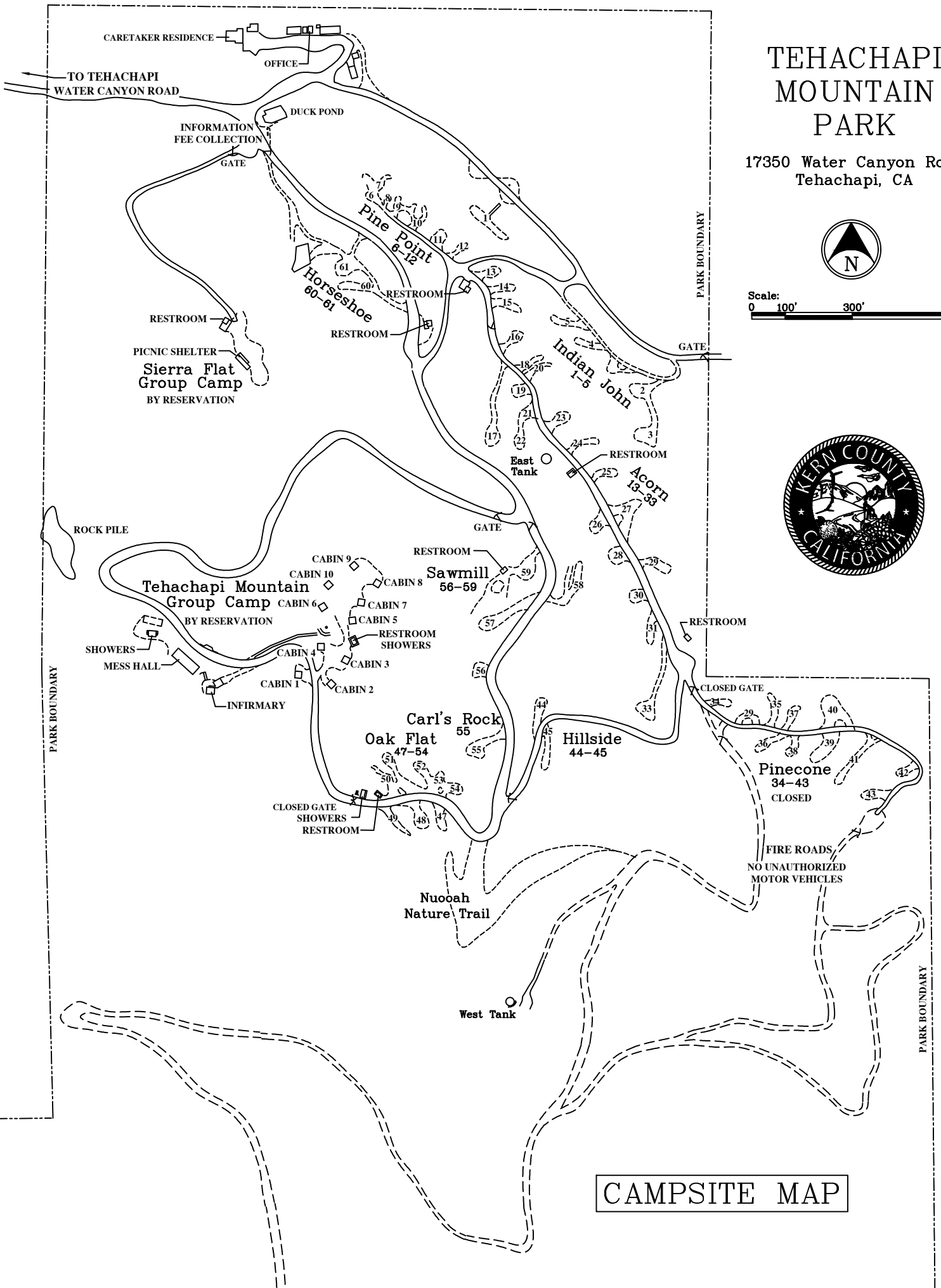


# TEHACHAPI MOUNTAIN PARK
